# Whole School Trip to Anderby Creek- Thursday 13th July

As part of our topic on 'holiday destinations' and 'sea-sides: past and present', we are taking the whole school on a trip to Anderby Creek on Thursday 13th July for what should be a fun-packed consolidation of learning and end of term treat. As the journey takes around an hour and a half, we will be leaving school at 8.45am, so would start the school day at the slightly earlier time of 8.30am. We will aim to return slightly later than normal finish time; at approximately 4pm.

Obviously, this trip will be very weather dependent, so we need to make plans for every eventuality. The children can come to school in appropriate clothing of choice, depending on

weather (shorts, T-shirt, jogging bottoms, jumper) as well as a warm, waterproof coat. Please could you make sure you also send your child/ren with a full change of clothes as well as a hat and suncream. Your child/ren will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink, plenty of water and several snacks as it will be a long day.

We asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.00 per child to go towards the cost of the trip. We recognise that times are difficult, so please be reassured that no student will be exclude from the event because of an inability to make a contribution. However, I should mention that without sufficient levels of voluntary contributions the trip will not be able to go ahead. Please contact us if you have any concerns.

There is a little shop at Anderby Creek, that sells shells and other small seaside items, so if you would like to send your child/ren with no more than £3.00 spending money we will ensure they get some time in the shop as part of the day's activities.

Please return the slip below giving your consent, and if your child is eligible for a universal/free lunch and you would like school to provide a packed lunch for them, please indicate this on the slip below and return it by **Friday 23rd June** so that packed lunches can be ordered in time.

## Early Morning Drop Off and After School Club

As you'll be aware, an EMDO and ASC service has been operating since February and has been well supported. We are in the process of reviewing the current provision for September and would like to extend it beyond the existing four mornings and two after school sessions. In order to help us with our planning, it would extremely helpful to know at this stage what the potential uptake and support from parents and carers might be come September, and so I would be grateful if you could complete the form below and return it to the office by **Wednesday next week**. We are working towards opening EMDO five days a week from 8am, and having After School Club provision in place every day of the week from 3.30pm to 6pm. The costs for each session would remain £3 for EMDO and £7.50 for ASC. We would be grateful for your feedback.
