Outdoor Learning

Summer seems to have finally descended and the children are really enjoying all of our outdoor learning sessions. In the sessions led by 'A Little Bit Wilder', the children have been busy working with clay, weaving natural materials, making fires and roasting marshmallows, amongst other things. They have now started to work towards the criteria for their badges, which you will receive more information about later this term.

We have joined the initiative 'Farmer Time' and have joined Farmer Sam for FaceTime sessions; where we have been given a tour of his farm, discussed seasonality and issues facing some of the crops and found out about some of the machinery used on the farm.

We have also focussed on our own Secret garden, planning and planting a range of produce, ready to be harvested later in the term. As the weather warms up, please ensure that your child has a hat, sun-cream and a water bottle with them each day for our outdoor sessions.

Newark Book Festival and Author Visit to the Owls

Our work with Newark Book Festival is continuing this term, with our entries for a creative writing competition about our local area. Entries will be exhibited at the Book Festival in Newark from 6th-9th July 2023. A booklet of events is attached with this letter. He will be leading a workshop in the Owls based on his successful book 'The Memory Thieves'.
