### **Dinners after Easter - Good Lookin Cookin**

Thank you again! to those of you who had time to come and sample the food Good Lookin Cookin brought into school on Tuesday's parents evening – general feedback was positive. Good Lookin Cookin (GLC) will be providing our school meals from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April when we return from the Easter Holidays, with Miss Benton continuing to serve meals and support staff during lunchtimes.

Please note that ordering meals for your child will be different from April. You will no longer place orders with school, but directly with Good Lookin Cookin (GLC) via their website – <a href="www.goodlookincookin.co.uk">www.goodlookincookin.co.uk</a>. You can order by the week, book over a longer period of time, amend and cancel meals. You will be required to open an account with GLC, and whilst doing so will be asked if your child is eligible for free school meals or Universal Infant Free School Meals (Year 1 and Year 2 pupil) - parents with children in these groups will not be required to pay for meals. Parents/carers who pay for their child's meals, will be asked to pay in advance for any meals ordered, and the cost will be £2.40 a day for two courses (this is cheaper than our current providers who is currently charging £2.95 per day).

Attached is a leaflet which includes a step-by-step guide to opening an account and ordering meals. Please note that in order to secure dinners for week commencing the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2024, you must have placed an order with GLC on their website by **10am on Thursday 4**<sup>th</sup> **April at the latest**.

During term time, you have until 10am on the Thursday to order meals for the following week. As a new term approaches, you will be asked to order food for the start of the new term by 10am on the Thursday before the children break up.

#### After School Club next term

A new term will see a change in clubs being offered. Sports Club on a Monday will focus on a range of sporting multi-skills, and on Thursday evenings we will be running a technology club. Wrap around care will also be available Monday to Fridays from 8am, and Monday to Thursday evenings 3.30pm to 6pm. Forms for booking sessions for both ASC and EMDO are attached to this letter. All clubs will be open on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April
