

Overview of reading: Key texts - Year B: Castles, Kings, Queens and Turrets - The Tudors (KS2)/ Great Fire of London (KS1), Invaders and Settlers - Anglo Saxons, Scots and Vikings (KS2) Earth and Space (KS1), Sun, Sea and Sand - Greece (KS2) Australia (KS1).

Our reading curriculum has been carefully designed to ensure that children are exposed to a variety of high quality texts, ranging from modern fiction, classic texts, science fiction, traditional tales, fairy tales, myths, legends, fantasy, picture books, graphic novels, poetry and non-fiction, including news reports. These texts have been selected to support and enhance learning throughout the wider curriculum, allowing children to make connections beyond their English lessons and develop a deep love of learning. Rich texts are selected, which form the foundation of our curriculum. Through our reading choices, we ensure that our children are supported to be the best they can be within our ever changing, diverse and eclectic society; choosing texts that expose them to a wide range of cultures and experiences which demonstrate that everyone has an equal opportunity to live, learn, and achieve.

This curriculum is changeable, depending on cohort size, ability and maturity. Also, new texts may be added as new books are published.

Our Big Cat reading scheme contains a range of quality texts that the children read independently: with regular assessments which measure comprehension and prosody, and the completion of tasks and book reviews regularly.
